Online event opens doors for international guests from the water industry

2nd BLUE PLANET Berlin Water Dialogues Conference 2021 // Sustainable Water Reuse Concepts

Berlin, 16th September 2021 - "Water Reuse: Opportunities and Challenges" is the topic of the BLUE PLANET Berlin Water Dialogues event series on 25th November 2021. After a successful implementation with nearly 700 participants in February, the organizers once again decided to hold the event in a virtual format - opening doors for representatives of the international water industry. Interested parties are invited to learn about the opportunities and challenges of water reuse and exchange ideas. The event is supported by the German Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation and Nuclear Safety and the Berlin Senate Department for Economics, Energy and Public Enterprises. Industry partner KSB is also supporting the event.

Considering the growing global challenges posed by climate change, the BLUE PLANET Berlin Water Dialogues bring together German and international representatives from the water and environmental sectors to discuss solutions for sustainable water resource management. Against the backdrop of the EU Water Reuse Regulation, which will become mandatory for all EU countries in 2023, the November edition focuses on the topic of water reuse. This regulation is intended to create uniform standards for the safe application of reuse of treated wastewater. Synergies and differences between national and global water reuse concepts will be discussed.

International experts from recognized organizations such as the German Federal Environment Agency (UBA), the German Association for Water Management (DWA) and the International Water Association (IWA) have already confirmed their participation. Participants will gain exciting insights into innovative, international application examples and technologies from Germany, Spain, Belgium and the US. In break-out sessions, participants are invited to learn about industrial reuse concepts and legislation, as well as to exchange experiences on the social acceptance of reuse concepts. Choosing the topic "Reuse", the organizers aim to contribute to an expansion of sustainable uses of treated water, and to bring together stakeholders from research, industry, and politics.


